

## Battles of the Revolutionary War Wonder Circle

You will be creating a wonder circle with information about an important battle during the Revolutionary War.

After researching your battle, write down the information required for each topic.

- Circle One - The name of the battle, date, and location of the battle
- Circle Two - A paragraph about George Washington and his role during the Revolutionary War (do not include anything about Presidency after the war)
- Circle Three - Identify the leaders and important heroes of the battle on both sides and the number of soldiers who fought in the battle on both sides. Include the number of casualties
- Circle Four - 5 interesting facts about the battle
- Circle Five - Describe the outcome (who won) and effect the battle had on the Revolutionary War

Research can be done using the internet, books, or an encyclopedia. There is not enough information in your textbook to use for research.

Directions for assembling the wonder circle -

Cut out the five circles and write information onto each circle.

Fold each circle in half with the writing on the inside (Make sure the writing is facing the same way)

Glue half of circle 1 to half of circle 2, glue the other half of circle 2 to half of circle 3, continue to glue until the last circle is attached to the first one
